



WATER IS PRECIOUS

Water is finite. Just 2.5 percent of the world's water is fresh, rather than seawater. Two-thirds of all fresh water that exists is locked in ice caps and glaciers. Of the remaining amount, twothirds is "lost" to evaporation. From what is left, some 20 percent is in areas too remote for human access, while of the other 80 percent, three-quarters comes at the wrong time or place, through monsoons, hurricanes and floods, and can only be partially captured for human use. The renewable fresh water supply on land is less than 0.08 of one percent of the total water on the planet. Of this tiny fraction of water available for human use, some two-thirds is devoted to agriculture, a figure that rises to more than 80 percent, sometimes 90 percent.
