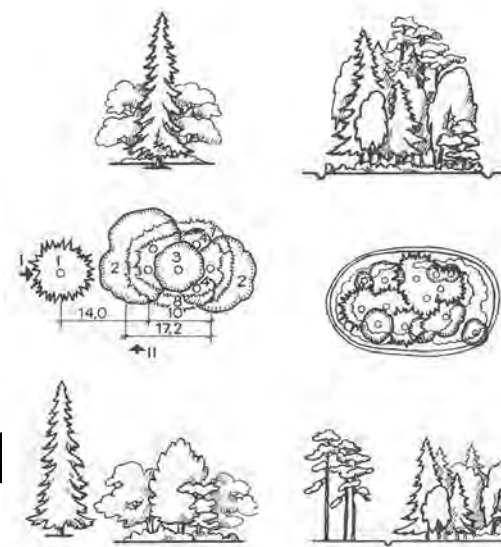

Detail landscape drawings of tree and shrub groups at Pavlovsky Park, south of St. Petersburg, Russia. Originally designed in the early nineteenth century by the Italian painter and theater scene designer Pietro Gonzaga, these groupings and the entire park landscape have been restored to its original design—a design that was decimated during the battle for Leningrad in World War II.
